Confessions During Holy Week

This Wednesday, traditionally known as "Spy Wednesday," is the last day for confessions during the season of Lent. Priests will be available on Wednesday from 4:00 - 8:00 p.m. on the hour. "On the hour" means that the priest will be in the confessional at the "top of the hour" and stay as long as needed. If no one is present at the top of the hour, the priest will wait for ten minutes and then leave until the next hour.

These are the last opportunities for confessions during Holy Week. During the Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, there will be no confessions.

Lenten Confessions

Prepare for Easter by making a Good Confession this week.

Here's how to go to Confession!

You say at the beginning of the Confession:

Bless me, Father, for I have sinned.

It has been _____ days/weeks/months/years since my last confession, and these are my sins.

Here is a brief Examination of Conscience to help you identify sins.

- Did I doubt or deny that God exists?
- Did I love God with my whole heart?
- Did I give time to God each day in prayer?
- Did I curse, or break an oath or vow?
- Did I lie?
- Did I commit perjury?
- Did I waste time at work, school, or at home?
- Did I deliberately deceive others, or injure others by lies?
- Did I gossip or reveal others' faults or sins?
- Did I show reverence to Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament?
- Did I miss Mass Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation through my own fault?
- Did I neglect my duties to my husband, wife, children or parents?
- Did I neglect to give good religious example to my family?
- Did I get angry, impatient, envious, unkind toward another person?
- Did I show pride, vengeance, jealousy, or hate toward another?
- Did I give a bad example by drug abuse, drinking alcohol to excess?Did I steal, cheat, or encourage others to steal or keep stolen goods?
- Have I made restitution for stolen goods?

Listen to the priest and the counsel that he gives you and the penance he instructs you to do. He will then ask you to recite the Act of Contrition, which can be found below. The priest will then absolve you of your sins and you may go and do the penance that the priest gave you.

The Act of Contrition: My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin.

Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us.

In his name, my God, have mercy. Amen.

Guidelines for Fasting/Abstinence during Lent

Abstinence is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. **Fasting** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for ages 18 - 59 (inclusive). The Church defines fasting as one meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal, as well as no eating between meals.

Note: If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial suitable to their condition.

Baptismal Prep

Parents and godparents are required to attend a baptismal preparation class before a child is baptized in the Catholic faith. The next class is scheduled for **Sunday**, **April 27**, **2025**, **at 4:30 p.m.** and will be held in the lower meeting room of Church. Contact the parish office to register and complete a baptismal registration form.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least **six months** in advance. (If you have been married before, an annulment may need to be done first.)


